### Scripture 1 Luke 9:28-36

28 About eight days after Jesus said this, he took Peter, John and James with him and went up onto a mountain to pray. 29 As he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became as bright as a flash of lightning. 30 Two men, Moses and Elijah, appeared in glorious splendor, talking with Jesus. 31 They spoke about his departure, which he was about to bring to fulfillment at Jerusalem. 32 Peter and his companions were very sleepy, but when they became fully awake, they saw his glory and the two men standing with him. 33 As the men were leaving Jesus, Peter said to

him, “Master, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters—one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.” (He did not know what he was saying.)

<sup>34</sup> While he was speaking, a cloud appeared and covered them, and they were afraid as they entered the cloud. <sup>35</sup> A voice came from the cloud, saying, “This is my Son, whom I have chosen; listen to him.” <sup>36</sup> When the voice had spoken, they found that Jesus was alone. The disciples kept this to themselves and did not tell anyone at that time what they had seen.

## Discussion Questions

### Question #1

**Jesus had a very difficult thing road ahead of him. He knew that soon the people He loved were going to reject him, betray him, make fun of him and even kill him. Do you think He was scared or sad?**

*The disciples loved Jesus, but many times they would not completely understand what Jesus was sent to do. Do you think that made Jesus feel a little lonely?*

*How do you think Jesus found strength to go on?*

### Question #2

**Can you imagine what it was like for those disciples who joined Jesus on the Mountain?**

*What questions would you have wanted to ask Jesus about what was happening?*

*The men with Jesus were Moses and Elijah. We can read about them in the Old Testament. Moses freed God’s people from slavery in Egypt and taught them God’s law. Elijah was a prophet of God who performed miracles and tried to tell people to turn their hearts back to God. Why do you think God had these men come to speak with Jesus?*

*What did God say about Jesus in verse 35?*

## **Question #3**

### **Read the following with me:**

While everyone was marveling at all that Jesus did, he said to his disciples,  
44 "Listen carefully to what I am about to tell you: The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men." 45 But they did not understand what this meant. It was hidden from them, so that they did not grasp it, and they were afraid to ask him about it.

46 An argument started among the disciples as to which of them would be the greatest. 47 Jesus, knowing their thoughts, took a little child and had him stand beside him. 48 Then he said to them, "Whoever welcomes this little child in my name welcomes me; and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me. For it is the one who is least among you all who is the greatest."

### **Why do you think the disciples were arguing about who was the greatest?**

*Is this something we ever think about/worry about?*

*(who is the fastest, smartest, prettiest, coolest, bravest, funniest)*

*Do you think those are things God wants us to worry about?*

*How can we let go of those kinds of thoughts?*
