The Holy Spirit Comes at Pentecost

2 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. **2** Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. **3** They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. **4** All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

5 Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. **6** When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard their own language being spoken. **7** Utterly amazed, they asked: "Aren't all these who are speaking Galileans? **8** Then how is it that each of us hears them in our native language? **9** Parthians, Medes and Elamites; residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and

Asia, **10** Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome **11** (both Jews and converts to Judaism); Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!” **12** Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, “What does this mean?”

13 Some, however, made fun of them and said, “They have had too much wine.”

Discussion Questions

Question #1

After Jesus rose from the dead, he appeared to the disciples and his followers many times. Then after 40 days, Jesus ascended into heaven, with all his friends watching. He told them to wait in Jerusalem for the helper to come. Do you know who God would send to help them?

On the day of Pentecost, they were all waiting together. What happened when Holy Spirit came?

The Holy Spirit still lives in those who believe in Jesus. He gives us strength to listen to and obey God. How does that make you feel?

The Holy Spirit also give everyone who believes in Jesus gifts so they can serve God and help others know about Jesus. Do you think God gave you a special gift to help others know Him?

Question #2

Have you ever heard someone speak a language you didn't understand?

What would you do if you needed to tell someone something important, but they didn't speak the same language as you?

In this story, there were many people visiting Jerusalem from all over the world. They did not all speak the same language as the disciples. Why do you think God gave the disciples a special ability to suddenly speak other languages?

How many languages does God know?

Question #3

Did you know, after Peter told people about Jesus on the day of Pentecost, 3000 people asked Jesus into their hearts? The disciples suddenly had to find a way to help people learn more about Jesus and take care of one another. What are four things you would do to help people learn about Jesus and take care of one another?
